SUMMARY/BACKGROUND:

In August 2022, the Park Board hosted an open house to gather public comment and weigh in on design options for Sunset Beach development. A survey was also distributed for comment by the public. The priorities that emerged were accessibility, safety and improving the natural environment.

Staff worked with the design consultants to incorporate comments and priorities into the plans. The plans are finalized and attached for the Park Board's review. Permits will be issued in approximately 30 days and the project will be constructed this summer.

SUMMARY/BACKGROUND:

Parks update May 2023

Cedarwood Clubhouse: The city was allocated \$1,123,000 in the State Capital Budget for Cedarwood. The city submitted a federal request and Representative Delbene recommended Cedarwood for inclusion in the federal budget. The federal budget is due by October.

Grants: The state budget includes a large allocation for several Recreation and Conservation Office grants. Two grants for Frontier Heights may be awarded to the city for phase II of this project. This will include the pickleball courts, athletic field, sensory garden and parking.

Eagle Ridge: The community gardens are open for rentals. The rules for the garden have been reviewed and changes have been made. The changes, in part, include a uniform set time of rental per year; updating the method you can rent as we are going to an online format; outlining expectations for garden use; and setting rules for the shed.

Events, Recreation & Culture:

- Pride on the Lake Festival will be June 24, 2023, at Lundeen Park.
 - Lake Stevens Farmers Market will return on June 7, 2023, at North Cove Park.
 - Lake Stevens Health and Wellness Festival will take place on June 25, 2023, at North Cove Park.
