**MOTION** by Commissioner Huber to authorize Commissioner Schmidt to file the 2025 salary of \$1,000 per month for City Council members with the City Clerk on December 4, 2024. Commissioner Hampton seconded. **MOTION** passed unanimously.

## Salary Commission Information Packet October 13, 2025 Meeting

Official Purpose of the Salary Commission: “It is the policy of the City of Lake Stevens to base salaries of elected officials on realistic standards so that officials may be paid according to the duties of their offices, so that citizens of the highest quality may be attracted to public service. (Ord. 914, Sec. 1, 2014)”

### Background:

On September 8, 2020, City Council passed Ordinance 1093 making the City of Lake Stevens Mayor position full-time upon the Salary Commission establishing the full-time salary. Since 2020, the Salary Commission has based their recommendations largely on comparable cities and cost-of-living increases provided to non-represented city employees.

The Mayor’s current 2025 salary is \$10,619.27 per month (\$127,431.20 annually)

The City Council’s 2025 current salary is \$1,000 per month (\$12,000 annually)
