City Clerk Chelin administered the Civil Service Commission oath of office to Joshua Wilson.

Chief Examiner/Secretary Good advised the Commission to save the date for the upcoming 41st Annual Civil Service (virtual) Conference, Sept. 20-22.

Recruiting and Staffing Update:

Deputy Police Chief Young provided an overview of staffing and recruiting:

- Community Service Officer vacancy will be filled from the Eligibility List
- Police Records Specialist vacancy created by promotion will be filled by an Eligibility List
- Police Officer-Lateral oral boards are being held next week, which will update the Eligibility List to fill three vacancies
- A Police Officer-Entry Level candidate is in the background process
- A Police Officer-Entry Level has been hired and will begin employment June 16th
- A Police Records Specialist vacant position was filled on June 7th
