In my career, I have shaped and responded to over 1500 RFQs and successfully guided organizations to capture over \$15 Billion dollars in State and Federal contracts for organizations like UPS, Grainger and Amazon. I am currently a consultant for Amazon, RTX and Huntington Ingalls for the Federal market, as well as multiple small and Veteran owned businesses in the Federal space.

I am a Board Member for the Coalition for Government Procurement in Washington DC. This group tracks, initiates and shapes legislation for Business with Government.

The past week in Washington DC with my fellow Council members and city staff, I was in my element. I was also fortunate enough to extend my trip and attend the Snohomish County Economic Development Alliance with Gene Brazel to meet with key Legislators to understand some of the issues and challenges Snohomish County leaders and businesses are facing.

I am the President and a Board Member of the North Sound Police Association, a 5014C that facilitates donations to nine local departments including Lake Stevens so they can self-fund equipment and training when the budget falls short. Chief Beazizo recognized our organization during his Chief's briefing at a recent Council meeting. The Foundation recently raised funds and provided a new K9, trainer and special K9 patrol vehicle for the Lake Forest Police Department.

I have owned and operate several small businesses and currently co-own the Lake Stevens Brewing Company. I understand and, at times, experience the challenges our small business community faces, and I am excited to continue advocating for them as a Chamber member. They have my support and I feel I have theirs.

We are fortunate to partner with Youth and High School sports teams, providing financial support to our young athletes. We support Cocoon House with donations and events, Sherwood Services with our annual “Sherwood like Another” beer that we brew and give the proceeds to help their mission. Empty Bowls for the Food Bank, Grad night, the list is endless and so is our support. If it belongs to Lake Stevens, we try to get to “yes,” every time.




He has an outstanding relationship with the county and state government officials that have jurisdiction over the city and works well with all those officials, as well as those in the federal delegation that serve our citizens.


